The **Business Excellence Award** salute individuals and companies that have distinguished themselves in areas such as entrepreneurship, longevity, growth, innovation, capital improvements, and consistent involvement in the community.

Selection Criteria:

- Exemplify the highest standards of their profession
- Demonstrate excellence and success in their business and profession
- Promote diversity, equality and inclusiveness in their workplace and/or professional capacity
- Model commitment to sustainability in daily business practices
- Demonstrate leadership in the community; engage in significant volunteer activities and be a positive role model for the Caribbean community
- Visibly support the Caribbean community through contributions and/or in-kind services to service organizations or other community-wide causes

The *Lifetime Achievement* Award honors someone who has played a significant role in empowering individuals within the Caribbean community.

Selection Criteria

- Recognizes the commitment and contribution of an outstanding individual toward the enrichment of the Caribbean community
- It is for a person, who has been a "voice" for the Caribbean for at least 15 years in the Rochester community
- It is for achievement that distinguishes the individuals work and provides a legacy for future generations
- It recognizes ongoing leadership and a career of excellent service to the Rochester and surrounding communities
- Is a Caribbean national or person of Caribbean heritage residing in the Rochester Community
- It is for someone who has been an ardent advocate for a cause that adds value to and brings pride to the Caribbean community in Rochester.

The *Champion Award* honors and recognizes individuals or organizations who have contributed significant efforts to influence and improve the quality of living for the Caribbean community in Rochester and its surrounding areas.

Selection Criteria

- Takes action and address barriers to full participation of the Caribbean Diaspora and supports the to be an inclusive, welcoming, working and living environment in the Rochester Community
- Supports initiatives and programs that significantly encourage the Caribbean community's full participation of all Caribbean members to benefit from working and living in an equitable, diverse and inclusive environment.
- Committed to providing access and opportunities for exposure for the residents of Rochester and its surrounding community to the Caribbean's rich diverse history and culture.

The *Community Service Award* highlights the remarkable commitment and dedication of individuals to a social cause, or their unstinting support to one or more not-for-profit or charitable organizations. The importance and results of volunteer work deserve to be recognized outside the organization that benefited from the volunteer's contribution.

Selection Criteria:

- Active participation in the development of his or her community
- Significant contribution as a volunteer within community or charitable organizations or other notfor-profit organizations
- Active involvement in committees or task forces
- Participation in activities or events as a member, honorary chair, organizer, etc.
- Demonstrated achievements that will have a strong positive impact in the Rochester community
